✓ **An introduction of Balochistan Human Rights Group (BHRG)**

Balochistan Human Rights Group (BHRG) is independent and non-profit human rights Non-Governmental Organization (NGO), that works on providing information to fill the gaps cause by the lack of independent media in Balochistan through investigation, effective communication and gathering reliable documents.

BHRG provides relevant, verified and up-to date information regarding the human rights situation in Western Balochistan.

✓ **Executions in Iran**

In January, at least 4 citizens were executed in Iranian prisons, all of whom had limited access to defense lawyers, fair trials, and proper legal procedures.

✓ **Fuel Carriers Casualties**

At least 7 fuel carriers were killed and 11 others injured in traffic accidents in Balochistan last month. Fuel carrying remains a common livelihood despite the ongoing risks from security forces and accidents.

✓ **Security Forces Killings**

In January, 9 Baloch citizens were killed by gunfire from security forces, and 6 others were injured.

✓ **Violence by Unknown Armed Individuals**

At least 12 Baloch citizens were killed, and 16 others were wounded by unknown armed individuals across Balochistan in the past month.

✓ **Destruction of Baloch Homes**

In the past month, three demolition operations took place in Balochistan. Without prior warning or court orders, the municipality and security forces destroyed homes in Shirabad, Zehdan, and Chabahar, leaving residents displaced.

✓ **Arrest of Baloch Citizens**

In January 2025, at least 67 Baloch citizens were arrested in Sistan and Balochistan and other cities in Iran. 38 of them were from a village in the Zahdan region and were later released. Authorities have not disclosed detailed information about the other detainees.
