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✓ **Introduction to Balochistan Human Rights Group (BHRG)**

Balochistan Human Rights Group (BHRG) is an independent and non-profit human rights Non-Governmental Organization (NGO) that works on providing information to fill the gaps caused by the lack of independent media in Balochistan through investigation, effective communication, and gathering reliable documents. BHRG provides relevant, verified, and up-to-date information regarding the human rights situation in Western Balochistan.

✓ **Executions in July 2026**

In July 2026, at least six Baloch prisoners were executed in Iranian prisons. Reports also documented the execution of several other prisoners, including Afghan nationals, in Taybad Prison.

Meysam Irandegani — July 21, 2026 | Iranshahr Prison

He was 18 at the time of execution and was 14 when the alleged offense occurred. He had been sentenced to qisas (retribution in kind) for murder.

Ali-Ahmad Yousefi — July 22, 2026 | Jiroft Prison

Approximately 34 years old. He had been sentenced to qisas for murder.

Abdolvahed Sangari — July 22, 2026 | Iran Shahr Prison

32 years old. He had been sentenced to qisas in connection with a tribal dispute and a murder charge.

Yasin Hashemzahi (Valani) — July 22, 2026 | Zahedan Central Prison

Approximately 26 years old. He had been sentenced to qisas for murder.

Eshaq Morraei — July 27, 2026 | Ferdows Prison

Married and father of five. He had been sentenced to death on drug-related charges.

Nader Abil — July 29, 2026 | Taybad Prison

Approximately 40 years old, married and father of four daughters. He was executed on drug-related charges.

Reports also stated that several other prisoners, including Afghan nationals, were executed at Taybad Prison on July 29.

✓ **Extrajudicial Killings / Direct Shootings**

Iranian security forces were responsible for the deaths of Baloch civilians through direct shootings in July 2026.

Eido Ghanbarzehi, Jamshid Alizehi, Abdolrahman Ghanbarzehi, and Tayeb Ghanbarzehi — July 11, 2026 | Shahrud Desert, Semnan Province

Four Baloch citizens were killed after units of the Semnan tactical police opened fire on two vehicles. Iranian authorities claimed that an exchange of fire had taken place between the security forces and the occupants of the vehicles.

Abdolkarim Bon (Mohammadhassani) — July 31, 2026 | Radeeg area, Pishin District, Rask County

The Baloch citizen was shot in the head and killed while returning from his orchard in the border area. According to sources cited by the Balochistan Human Rights Group, border forces opened fire without prior warning.

✓ **Arrests**

At least eight Baloch citizens — July 28, 2026 | Chah Ahmad village, Nazil District, Taftan County

Military and security forces raided several homes and arrested at least eight Baloch citizens, transferring them to an undisclosed location. Reports stated that some of those arrested were beaten in front of their family members.

The detainees were identified as Hamid Shahbakhsh, Kamran Shahbakhsh, Habib Shahbakhsh, Saeed Shahbakhsh, Akbar Shahbakhsh, Naser Shahbakhsh, Mohammad Shahbakhsh, and another member of the Ghanbarzehi family whose full identity remained under investigation.

✓ **Raid and Destruction of a Home**

Family of a Baloch citizen identified by the surname Pahank — July 28, 2026 | Kent village, Hiduch District, Sib and Suran County

Intelligence Ministry agents raided the family's home without presenting a judicial warrant, breaking windows and damaging the building and household property during the search. According to sources, one child with a disability suffered a seizure as a result of the violent raid, while another child was reportedly beaten by the agents.
