Iran executes all men of a Balochistan village

Shahindokht Molavardi Deputy of Women Affairs for the President of Iran has claimed that all the men of a Balochistan village have been executed for drug offenses. She also claimed that there are no moral or financial support offered to the families of the executed. According to BHRG sources, there are many villages in Balochistan where the majority of men have been executed for different offenses.

Extra Judicial Killings of Baloch

Two youths in Zahedan were targeted and killed by military forces. The first, Mohammad Regi, 28, was killed on 5 March 2016 in the area of Rasouli junction, Zahidan. The second, Ehsan Shahbakhsh (YarmohammadZai), was killed on 10 March 2016, in Khorramshahr St. Another youth, Amin Shahnavaizi son of Shadikhan, a student, was killed in Saravan on 1 March 2016, while on his way home.



Execution Of Baloch People

Mr Khalid Kurdi and Moslim Abarian were executed in Yazd Central Jail on 25 January 2016. They were jailed for seven years. Sources say both were underage (under thirteen years) when arrested seven years ago.
