

Sajjid Hussain, Baloch Human Rights activist died in Sweden

[Sajjid Hussain](#), a human rights activist and prominent Baloch journalist went missing in Uppsala city, Sweden, on the 2nd March 2020. After more than a month on the 23rd April 2020, he was found dead at the outskirts of Uppsala near a river. Sajjid had been working as a journalist with many news agencies in Pakistan. Due to his articles written about missing Baloch people and against drug mafias in Balochistan, he was forced to flee from his home country. He came to Sweden in 2017 as a political refugee where he later began working as a Balochi language lecturer at Uppsala University, alongside that at the university he was

also the chief editor of 'Balochistan Times', a digital news website. The facts about his disappearance and death still remain unknown and police investigation continues. No autopsy report has been published yet.

Human Rights violations in Balochistan, committed by Iranian regime under month April 2020

1. On April 2nd 2020, Abbas Bamari, Son of Dad Mohamad, a resident of Chah Kamal Zehkaloot in Kerman province was assassinated by unidentified gun men. Baloch youths are often killed by Iranian security intelligence and paramilitary
2. On April 6th 2020, Vahid Sheihaki, son of Sharif was killed by military forces in Bam, Kerman Province.

3. On April 8th 2020, Mohammad Baram, son of Aziz from [Jakigur](#), Rask was killed by the Pakistani Army in Mand District while smuggling oil. Many Baloch youths are being killed on a daily basis by both countries border forces in order to stop oil smuggling.
4. On April 20th 2020, in a clash between the Revolutionary Guards and Baloch citizen, three citizens named Mohammad, Mohammad Ali and Rahman Shahbakhsh, along with a Baloch member of the revolutionary guard where killed in Shaston, Saravan. Iranian state media identified the three Baloch citizens as youth drug traffickers.
5. On April 21st 2020, the dead body of a Baloch citizen, Nazem Khatoni, son of Nawaz was found in the city of Chahbar. The cause and motive of the murder has not been identified.
6. On April 23rd 2020, Abdul Basit Dahani, 28 year old, son of Lidok, a Baloch political prisoner executed in Zahedan central prison. He was arrested on July 2016 and charged with acting against national security.
7. On April 25th 2020, two Baloch citizens, Zahed Baloch, son of Mohammad from Mand and Fazl Baloch, son of Allah Bakhsh from Nazarabad were assassinated by unknown individuals in the city of Pishin.

Arbitrary Detentions:

1. On April 22nd 2020, Maktoum Askani, son of Mohammad Amin, a relative of Molavi Koohi was summoned and interrogated by Dozap revolutionary intelligence in related to Molavi Kohi's case.
2. On April 26th 2020, military and security forces raided the village of [Dargs](#), district of [Chabahar](#) and arrested 10 people.
3. On April 27th 2020, police raided the village of Kendal in the city of [Sirik](#) and took some of the citizens' boats with them.
4. On April 29th 2020, again security forces raided the same village of [Dargas](#) and arrested a Baloch citizen named Aziz Raisi without court order. This is linked to the previous arrestment of 10 people in the same village, security forces illegally arrest Baloch citizens without any warrants in order to enforce fear and harassment.



Iranian regime systematic descrimnations against Balcoh people, inside Balochistan

1. On April 4th 2020, Milad Nazeri Rad, a 21 year old from Zahak City in the north of Balochistan drowned in the canal leading to the unfinished well.
2. On April 7th 2020, two children drowned in the Pamont dam in Ghaserghand. They were 12 year old Morteza Darzadeh, son of Mostafa and 13 year old named Erfan Dorzadeh, son of Iqbal. No warning signs were installed to indicate that swimming was prohibited and dangerous.
3. On April 7th 2020, two girls aged 14 and 18 drowned in a river in the village of Sarzeh, the county of Sirik in Hormozgan province.
4. On April 9th 2020, a child named Ali Asghar Behra from Aref Abad village drowned in the hotag ;a natural or artificial pit that people use to drink water;. At present there is no water supply network in Dashtyari area of Chabahar city.
5. On April 21st 2020, citizens' houses in Mirabad was demolished by 'Chabahar Housing and Urban Development Administration'. The agency believes that the land where the people lived was occupied illegally, so had been seized by the agency.
6. On April 25th 2020, a 15-year old boy died at the Iran - Afghanistan border terminal in Hirmand city after being hit by a truck.
