

The Iranian regime continue the execution of Baloch prisoners

Iran recently resumed its mass execution of Baloch prisoners in Balochistan and other states. In fact, some of the prisoners have been in prison for a few years now with some only being sentenced to imprisonment, but, due to pressure from the Iranian intelligence service and Iran's revolutionary Guard Corps their sentences were upgraded to execution.

Continuation of executions:

1. Majid Rigi, executed on January 9, 2021

Majid was imprisoned in Zahedan Central Prison for 10 years charged with "possession of drugs". After 10 years of being in prison, the judicial officials in Iran decided to execute him.

2. Juma Zaruzehi, executed on January 13, 2021

Juma who was a taxi driver in the city of Dost Mohammad and Zabul had been involved in a fight over a passenger."

This incident happened about three years ago. The source added: "Jama's clash with another taxi driver led to the murder of the other side with a knife.

3. Mohammad Anwar Alizehi, executed on January 19, 2021

Mohammad Anwar who was charged with "possession of drugs" was arrested two and a half years ago in Junabad and was in Dozap Central Prison during that time.

4. Two Baloch citizens executed on January 20, 2021

Hafez Abdul Sattar was arrested eight years ago charged with murder. He was innocent as the murder was committed by other people who had contact with him, they escaped the murder scene but were later arrested by security agents."

On January 20, 2021, the death sentences of two Baloch citizens named Younes Jamshidzahi (Hafez Abdul Sattar), son of Malik Mohammad from Khash city and Shamsuddin Baji Zehi, son of Ibrahim, resident of Rutak village, Khash city, were carried out in Zahedan Central Prison.

The two citizens were arrested on January 18, 2014, charged with murder and held in Zahedan Central Prison for seven years.

5. Abdul Raouf Kabdani executed on January 23, 2021

Abdul Raouf, along with his three young children were arrested in November 2015 on drug charges at the Milak border.

After Abdul Raouf was arrested his young children were handed over to his family. "Abdul Raouf has no previous criminal record. According to the law on deprivation of the death penalty for carrying 'opium' drugs up to a few hundred kilos without any weapons, the punishment is only a prison sentence. According to 'Article On the law for carrying opium drugs the punishment for 'anyone who carries and stores more than five kilograms of opium will be fined 3 to 5 million Tomans and sentenced to ten to twenty five years in prison. If repeated, the drugs will be confiscated and they will be executed, with the exception of providing the cost of a normal life for the convicted person's family.

6. Anvar Naroui executed on January 28, 2021

Anvar Naroui, the son of Yar Mohammad from Iranshahr was sentenced to death for drug-related offences. He was executed in Dastgerd prison in Isfahan. Officials met his family the day before he was executed.

7. Javid Dehghan Khald executed January 30, 2021

A Baloch political prisoner named Javid Dehghan Khald was executed in Zahedan central prison. Javid, who was 31 was arrested on June 5, 2015 and sentenced to death by Branch 1 of the Revolutionary Court of Zahedan on charges of "Moharebeh"[opposing against religion beliefs] about two years after his arrest. The case that the officials brought forward about the prisoner had many flaws. There was even support from Amnesty International and the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights who called for his execution to be stopped.

The Islamic Republic Of Iran's Hostage taking:

Over the past month, the Islamic Republic of Iran's regime has made arbitrary arrests inside Iran of relatives and friends of political opponents living outside of Iran, this is in order to put pressure on those outside of Iran to either cease their activities or give themselves up to the regime.

One of the measures The Islamic Republic of Iran's Regime has used is the transfer of two Baluch prisoners named Amanullah Baluchi and Abdolrahim Koohi to Solitary confinement of Zahedan Central Prison on January 16, 2021 for execution. The Islamic Republic of Iran's Regime had told the families of these prisoners to hand over the two political opponents named Abdullah Parsa and Abdolhai Jalabi in order to alleviate the punishment of the two men. The two opponents of the regime surrendered to the security forces on January 19, 2021, but so far there is no news about their situation.

1. Abdul Rahman Baloch - January 25th

A Baloch citizen named Abdul Rahman Baluch, the son of Mohammad from Qasr Qand was arrested in Zahedan after being summoned by the IRGC intelligence. Abdul Rahman's brother is a member of an opposition group against the Islamic Republic of Iran.

3. Ahmad Habir, January 26th

Security forces raided the home of a political activist living outside of Iran and arrested his uncle, Ahmad Habir and his uncle's wife. His uncle, Ahmed, was released a few days later, but no information is available about his condition.

2. Ayub Khedir - January 27, 2021

The Islamic Republic of Iran's security forces raided the house of a Baloch citizen named Ayub Khedir, the son of Mohammad from Rask city where he was then arrested. His detention was accompanied by violence and ill-treatment while security forces took him to an unknown location without any court order. One of the relatives of this citizen is a political opponent of the Iranian regime.

4. Hasil Habir - January 30, 2021

Security forces raided the home of a Baloch citizen named Hasil Habir, the son of Bashir Ahmad, a resident of Pishin city. He was arrested after being beaten, then taken to an unknown location.
